

## Student Achievement Data

It typically takes a full-time student taking approximately 15 credits per semester over four years to complete the BFA interior design degree program. The following data was collected using Institutional Research data and alumni surveys administered by RIT's Office of Career Services and Cooperative Education six months after graduation.

### Job Placement Rates

- 92 % Placement Rate (87% Knowledge rate), Graduates 2023. 1 reported attending graduate school\*
- 100 % Placement Rate (80% Knowledge rate), Graduates 2022. 2 reported attending graduate school
- 100 % Placement Rate (95% Knowledge rate), Graduates 2021. 2 reported attending Grad School

### Student Attrition and Retention Rates

- 91 % of first-time students admitted in the fall of 2023 returned to the program in the fall of 2024
- 94 % of first-time students admitted in the fall of 2022 returned to the program in the fall of 2023
- 100 % of first-time students admitted in the fall of 2021 returned to the program in the fall of 2022

#### Six-year graduation rates

- 79 % 2023- 2024 Graduates; Fall 2017 freshman cohort
- 90 % 2022- 2023 Graduates; Fall 2016 freshman cohort
- 100 % 2021- 2022 Graduates; Fall 2015 freshman cohort
